Parent Email Privacy

- Samantha reiterated to the group that the email (online survey) did not come from the PAC, but the administration. Suggestion put forward that the PAC runs its own email/communications to the parents for next year.

Teacher Funding Request – outdoor gear and library

- This falls under the special initiatives in the PAC budget
- Google doc to go out to teachers/tutors/support to ask them what they need
- Trish waiting on replies
- Requests so far –
 - Outdoor Education Gear – request for grades 11 and 12 from Heath Pierson, camping equipment to cost an estimated \$750.
 - Library request- storage bins (6 were purchased so far from last years Freezie Sale) 1or 2 more stools, red bins and books
 - Sports Equipment – Mr. Hanson requested new badminton nets, and goalie padding, with a request of \$300 to cover this.
- Motion to approve Mr. Hanson’s \$300 request – all approved. Money to be taken from the Sports Equipment Donation.

- Library funding – all approved for the annual \$1000 library donation.
- Outdoor School request - \$400 will be given towards this request taken from the Sports Equipment Donation”. There is now \$300 remaining.

Advisory Circle Update

- Tanya Hill and Marissa attended the first meeting. It was held in the high school church portable.
- Karen is still interested in being a part of the advisory circle, she will contact Marissa.

Spring Raffle Update

- Prize donations were done in one week. The signup.com site worked exceptionally well, as all four prizes have been donated by families.

Hot Lunch Update

- Per Natalie – We have a new supplier called Foodie Kids. Everything has run better, nutrition is better with a well-balanced food choices. Sign up has been superb, over 100 order items on first day.
- Well Fed will check in on our program next year to see if we are happy or if we want to go back them.
- There is a 7% gain or markup on lunches. We have kept it low to enable all families to afford the hotlunch.
- We have already gained as Foodie Kids does not use Munch a lunch system. The old program cost the school \$350 to run.
- A breakdown of the # of families in elementary and high school ordering hot lunch will be provided at a later date.
- Update on the orders will be discussed at the next PAC meeting.
